Film Programming Internship

Application Deadline: December 17, 2023

Location: Virtual/Remote (Residency in the Indianapolis area a plus)

Compensation: \$500 total stipend + college credit (if needed)

Internship dates: January - September 2024

Up to 9 positions available

The Film Programming Interns are responsible for assisting the Film Programming Team with the film selection process for the Academy Award®-Qualifying Indy Shorts International Film Festival (July 23 – 28, 2024) and the 33rd Heartland International Film Festival (HIFF) (October 10-20, 2024) in Indianapolis. This virtual position will primarily assist the Film Programming Team with screening/reviewing festival submissions, festival program scheduling, and research/data entry.

Interns are expected to work a schedule of 12-20 hours per week (between Monday-Friday, our working hours are 9 am - 5 pm EST) with the potential to work more hours during the 2024 Indy Shorts International Film Festival and Heartland International Film Festival.

Interns who live in or near Indianapolis can assist onsite during the festivals.

Requirements:

- Current undergraduate or graduate student, or recent graduate (no earlier than Summer 2023).
- Preferably live in the Eastern or Central time zones in the United States during the internship OR be available to work a set schedule of 12-20 hours per week between the hours of 9 am - 5 pm Eastern time.
- Interns should have a personal computer and reliable access to the Internet suitable for streaming HD video.

Duties including, but not limited to:

- Processing and organizing/sorting film submissions in FilmFreeway (training provided)
- Assisting Film Programming Coordinator with assigning submissions and managing volunteer screener workflow
- Researching potential films and maintaining spreadsheets
- Screening short and feature film submissions
- Other data entry/management as needed

Film Programming Intern (up to 8 positions available)

January - early September 2024

What you will be doing:

Duties including, but not limited to:

- Screening submitted short and feature film submissions and participating in the programming selection process.
- Assist with content gathering and proofreading/editing for the 2024 Indy Shorts and Heartland International Film Festival ticketing site, print guide, and social media, and other materials.
- Assist with FilmFreeway and film festival research
- During the festival(s): assist across departments based on festival needs and intern interests if intern can be onsite in Indianapolis during the festival.
