The Academy Award®-Qualifying Indy Shorts International Film Festival presented by Heartland Film is the largest shorts festival in the Midwest running in Indianapolis, Indiana, since 2018, and has been named one of the top 20 Best Short Film Festivals in the World for 2022 by MovieMaker Magazine.

The High School Film Competition is a portion of the festival, which was created to encourage tomorrow's filmmakers to follow their passion and create short films that push their talents, creativity and art to the next level.

High School Film Competition alumni have gone on to attend the top 25 ranked film schools and win awards at SXSW and other festivals.

## Awards

Shorts made by talented high school students from around the world will compete for the Best Student Film Awards in the categories of Narrative, Documentary, Animated, and Indiana Spotlight (\$500 cash prize each). These category winners will then compete for the \$2,000 Summer White Lynch Memorial Award, underwritten by Gary D. & Marlene Cohen.
